

Kitchen/dining area Moira used Ikea's online design tools to manage the details in the kitchen. This meant she could order her fridge online from The Good Guys and when it was delivered, it fit perfectly into the gap allocated, with only 10mm to spare. The airy kitchen/dining space, is fitted out in Ikea's 'Abstrakt Faktum' cabinetry in white. Window treatments are minimal, with simple white venetians and plain roller blinds all custom-made by Blind Elegance.



Dining area Hours of trawling the internet proved worthwhile when Moira found the 'Fence Paling' refactory dining table and complementary benches from Furnish.com.au. "When you shop online, you can be faced with miles and miles of not nice things but you can find a gem," she says. With only a narrow space for dining, Moira chose benches, softened with 'Futon' cushions from Rapee, to squeeze as many people around the table as possible. The 'Fossus Vessel' vase from Freedom provides a hit of the requisite beachy blue.



Living area Now a champion of chain store shopping, Moira rounded out the space's look with a 'Regloit' floorlamp from Ikea. A tray and wicker candle holder, both from Orson & Blake, stand on the 'Klubbo' coffee table from Ikea. Other accessories add touches of colour and home comfort, such as the 'Zoe' throw and assorted cushions from Country Road, Abode Bazaar and Moochinside.
